THE MARCH OF THE LIVING brings together thousands of Jewish teens from all over the world to Poland and Israel.

In Poland you will search for traces of a world that is no more walking the three kilometers from Auschwitz to Birkenau the largest concentration camp complex built during World War II on a "March of the Living". From

Poland you will fly to Israel observing Yom HaZikaron, Israel Memorial Day and celebrating Yom Ha'Atzmaut, Israel Independence Day, on this milestone 75th year.

Open to students in 11 & 12th grade (10th by advance permission) are eligible to participate; all applicants are carefully screened and interviewed. All application materials must be submitted for consideration.

Cost: \$6,995. (This reflects a \$350 built-in scholarship thanks to generous funding from the International March of the Living) The fee does not include domestic airfare. Domestic fees TBA. Needs-based scholarships available.
